Mathematics

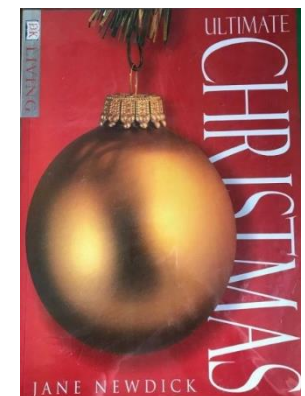
- Select, rotate and manipulate shapes in order to develop special reasoning skills.
