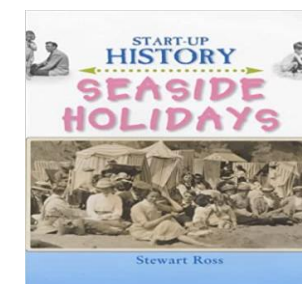
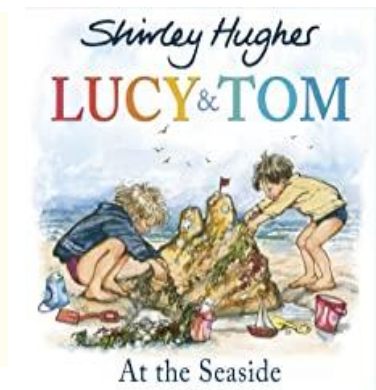
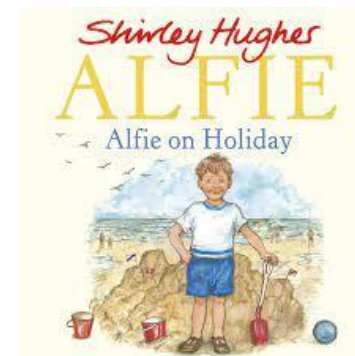
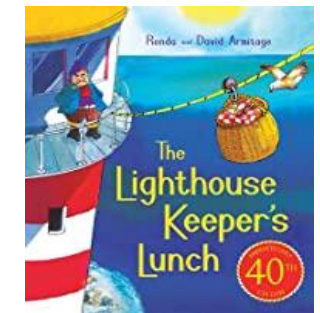
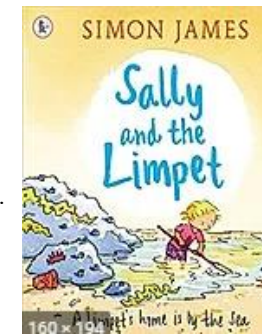
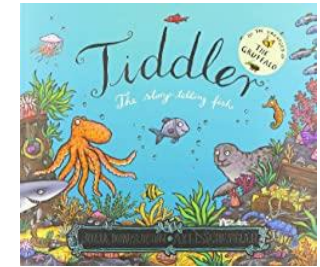
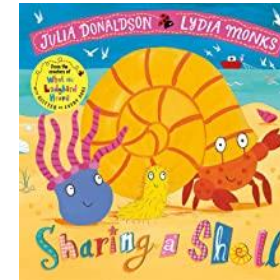
- Develop their small motor skills so they can use a range of tools competently, safely and confidently.

Vocabulary	
Harthill	See previous vocabulary from geography units.
Coast	Land joining or near to the sea
Shore	The land along the edge of the sea.
Waves	A long body of water, curling and breaking onto the shore.
Harbour	A place on the coast where ships can moor and shelter from high winds and rough seas.
Lighthouse	A tower or structure containing a beacon light to warn or guide ships at sea.
Pier	A platform of pillars projecting from the shore into the sea.
Cliff	A steep rock face especially at the edge of the sea.
Beach	A pebbly sand or shore next to the sea.
Habitat	The natural home or environment of an animal, plant.
Rock pool	A pool of water among rocks, typically along the shoreline.
Shell	The hard protective outer case of a mollusc or crustacean
Holiday	A period of leisure time spent away from home.
